10am Board Disney transport to EPCOT

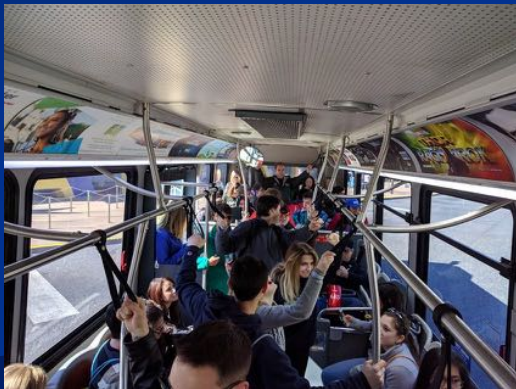

**CFAR coverage is 75% of the non-refundable trip cost (subject to the maximum benefit amount in the Plan). CFAR is optional and available for purchase at the individual level. Trip cancellation must be 48 hours or more prior to scheduled departure. CFAR must be purchased at the time of original plan purchase and with or before the final payment for your trip. You must have paid all non-refundable trip costs to the travel supplier prior to cancellation. For 50 Trip Cost there is no CFAR. This benefit is not available to residents of New York State.

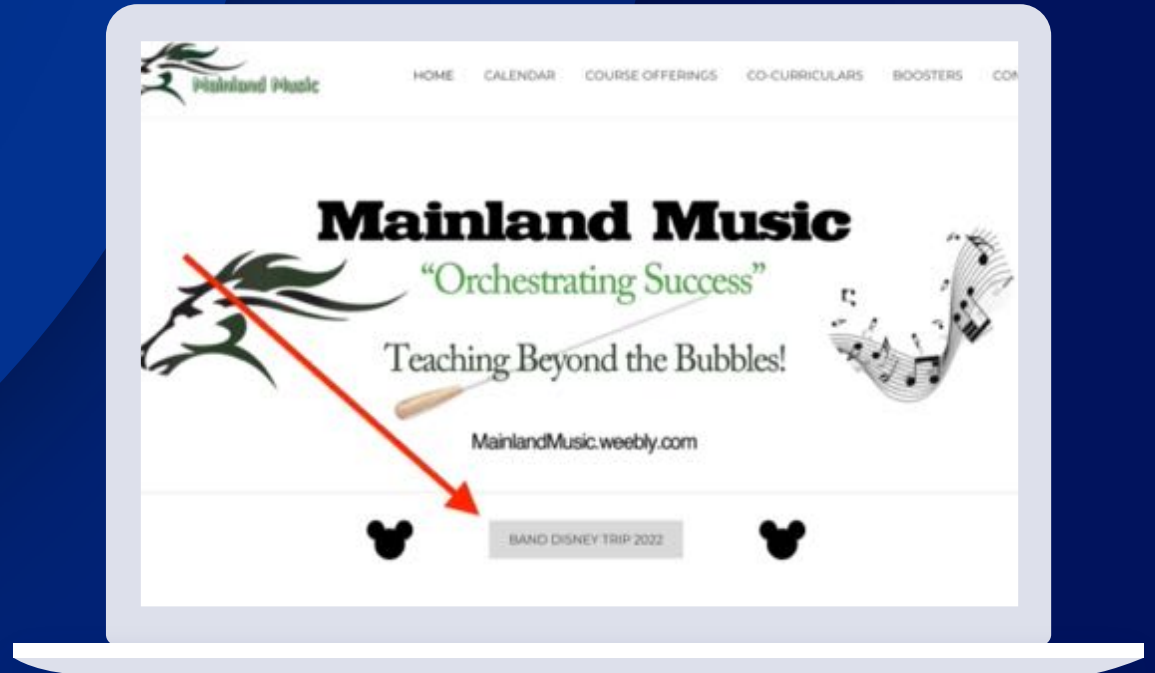
